Mobility Scholarship at University of Turin (Italy) in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA171

Erasmus+ programme KA171 is a project aiming at fostering cooperation in the field of Higher Education between University of Turin (Italy) and National Institute of Agronomy Tunisia. The programme-mobility offers the possibility to spend a period of training at University of Turin (https://en.unito.it/) for PhD Students from the National Institute of Agronomy Tunisia.

In order to apply for a grant within the framework of Erasmus + KA171, candidates must comply with the following general requirements:

- Students must be registered in the National Institute of Agronomy Tunisia and enrolled in Doctoral studies.
- Students must have sufficient knowledge of the English language (B1).

By respecting gender balance, priority will be given to students:

- with disabilities,
- from under-privileged social and economic backgrounds.

Duration of the mobilities: PhD: 9 months

Fields of studies and training: Agriculture, interdisciplinary programs (code 0818).

Amount of grants

The Erasmus+ for study scholarships are contributions to support living costs in the hosting country. The scholarship for Italy is 900 € per month.

Students will receive an additional amount of 309 € to cover the cost of travel. Beneficiaries are responsible for:

- Contracting their travel arrangements.
- Visa expenses.
- Contracting insurance cover.

- Knowledge of English (B1)
- Curriculum Vitae (European CV Europass)
- Motivation letter
- Proof of pre-registration in the National Institute of Agronomy
- Research proposal
- Learning Agreement (See annex)

The documents must be submitted **personally by the applicant to the National Institute of Agronomy** and the Institution will be responsible for selection procedures on the basis of transparent and fair criteria.

The deadline for applying is fixed at 10/07/2025.
